The American Lung Association and Sunday River Outdoor Center will host the 25th Annual Joy of Skiing event on Saturday, February 25, 2012. The Joy of Skiing is designed for skiers and (new last year and very popular) snowshoers of all ages and skill levels who enjoy recreating on and along groomed trails and eating a variety of entrees and snacks along the way. Yes, we have snow!!

Designated dining locations along the trail system offer participants a progressive picnic on skis. The traditional favorites of donuts, freshly made and served trailside by the Smith family, and hot Brew Pub soup at the covered bridge are back. Skiers and snowshoers will also enjoy a nice selection of homemade goodies at one of the food stations and S'mores at the firepit. Each hour between 10:00am and 3:00pm a different dining station opens along the trail system.
