Getting Here

BY CAR

From the south, follow I-95 to Exit 63, then Rt. 26 north approximately 50 miles to Bethel. Bethel is located prominently at the intersection of state highways 26, 2, and 5.

BY AIR

Commercial flights are available to Portland, Maine (PWM; 1.5 hour minute drive), Manchester, NH (MHT; 2.5 hour drive), or Boston, MA (BOS; 3.5 hour drive or bus & train service will get you as far as Portland). From Portland, car rental or private shuttle service is available.

The **Bethel Regional Airport** offers a 3,818' runway where visual flight rules apply. Tie-downs, hangar storage, and self-serve fuel are available. FMI: (207) 512-5552, bethelregionalairport.com.

SUMMIT RIDGE TRAIL - BETHEL COMMUNITY FOREST

0.75 to 3.2 miles, 1.5-2 hours, depending on route

GETTING THERE: Take the North Road off of Route 2/26/5 for 2 miles, then right onto Daisy Bryant Road, for 0.2 miles, then right on Locke Mountain Road (follow signs and respect the neighbors). Follow the Locke Mountain Road for 0.6 miles until reaching the parking lot.

WHAT TO EXPECT: The Summit Ridge Trail is designed to be easy to moderate, following the contours of the terrain as it ascends the ridge where it takes in sweeping views to the south and west. It follows blue blazes from the parking lot in the Bethel Community Forest terminating at a turnaround point at a scenic overlook. The trail emerges at Picnic Knoll, complete with a picnic table, 0.6 miles from the trailhead. From there, the trail ascends a ridge with a mix of terrain on rocks before emerging at another logging road. Cross the road and ascend through more rock and small ledge openings before emerging at the West Ledges at 1.2 miles. Continue a gentle climb through a sub-alpine forest, past a viewpoint, and then to high view of the Bingham Forest valley where the trail ends at 1.6 miles. Return the way you came.

BUCK'S LEDGE & LAPHAM LEDGE

1-2 miles, 1 hour

GETTING THERE: From Bethel village, go south on Route 26. From the intersection of Howe Hill Road in the Locke Mills of Greenwood, continue for 2.1 miles to a small parking lot on the left at the top of a rise. Find EV stations here.

WHAT TO EXPECT: These trails start together on a gravel road. At 0.5 miles, the trail to Lapham Ledge leaves the road and goes to the right at a sign. The Lapham Ledge trail continues another 0.5 miles to the Ledges where there are mountain and pond views to the south and east.

To reach Buck's Ledge, go past the Lapham Ledge trail and continue hiking on the road for another 0.2 miles, where the trail to Buck's Ledge breaks away from the road on the left. Continue 0.6 miles to the top of a long ledge to enjoy views of North and South Ponds, Mount Abram, and the Mahoosuc and White Mountains in the distance.

MAGGIE RING'S NATURE PARK

Up to 3.4 miles, 2 hours

GETTING THERE: The parking lot and two trailheads for Maggie's Nature Park are on the Greenwood Road on the west side of South Pond in the Town of Greenwood. From Bethel, take Howe Hill Road off of Route 26. Go over the RR tracks and turn left onto Greenwood Road. Continue for 1.4 miles and turn right at the sign into the parking lot.

WHAT TO EXPECT: Maggie Ring's Nature Park is laid out in a well-marked network of loops. Check the map at the trailhead before setting off. The trails are mostly quite gentle – great for beginners, kids, or just getting out for an hour or two of fresh air. The most scenic spot of the park is Peaked Mountain Bluff with views overlooking Twitchell Pond. Additional views include North and South Ponds along the Ledge Trail and Mount Abram after a moderate climb on the Loop Trail.



No matter the season, no matter the level of challenge, you'll discover a hike to love near Bethel. Trails range in difficulty from a paved pathway along the Androscoggin River, all the way on up to the most challenging mile of the Appalachian Trail. It's an easy drive to the White Mountain National Forest to the west, Grafton Notch State Park to the north, and an ever-growing array of trails on other conserved lands.

THE APPALACHIAN TRAIL

The AT is a legendary route that traverses from northern Maine to Georgia, passing just north and west of Bethel. Thru-hikers can take roughly six months to hike the whole thing, but you can say you hiked just a bit of it by leaving from the Grafton Notch trailhead for short-but-steep hikes to either the Table Rock or the Eyebrow viewpoints; try Old Speck or Baldpate for daylong adventures. maine.gov/graftonnotch

THE MAHOOSUC WAY:

PLEDGE TO EMBRACE OUR PLACE With increasing numbers of people using our great outdoors, users need to be mindful of their impact on the land. Always have a back-up plan in case you get to an area with an alreadyfull trailhead. While hiking, stay on the trail to be respectful of the landowner, never leave trash behind, and don't damage any natural or human-made features. 

Road Trips

WILDLIFE VIEWING AND LAKE COUNTRY LOOP

TOTAL: 146 miles, drive time 3 hrs 15 mins



- Route 2 East to Newry 6 miles
- Left on Route 26 to Errol, NH 31 miles
- Right on Route 16 to Oquossoc, ME 35 miles
- Left on Route 4 to Rangeley 7 miles
- Return to Oquossoc on Route 4 7 miles
- Left on Route 17 to Mexico 35 miles
- Right on Route 2 to Bethel 24 miles

Make a day of this route if you can. Viewing potential is high for moose, deer, eagles, and more. After leaving Bethel, pass through

Grafton Notch State Park with its stunning views and several natural roadside attractions. Approaching the villages of Oquossoc and Rangeley, mountains get taller and the lakes are huge. Hit Rangeley for lunch, shopping, and sightseeing, then return to Oquossoc where you'll turn south on Route 17. This National Scenic Byway leads to a famous overlook known as the Height of Land, the highest point on the road, commanding views of the mountains and lakes to the west. Route 17 continues south past a stunning gorge and waterfall at Coos Canyon, then along the Swift River to the towns of Mexico and Rumford, where you will connect with Route 2 west along the Androscoggin River back to Bethel.

- Left on Route 113 to Fryeburg 29 miles

Route 113, a National Scenic Byway, is the twistiest-turniest road around, traveling through Evans Notch on the eastern edge of the White Mountains. Cruising along the Wild River under a canopy of trees is enchanting. In spots, the views open up to the White Moun-

tains beyond as you continue through old farmsteads and into Stow and on to Fryeburg. Several roadside pull-outs offer views and hiking trailheads with trails for all abilities. As you return on Route 5, you'll pass by beautiful lakes and the charming villages of Lovell and Waterford.

NORTHWEST: GRAFTON NOTCH STATE PARK + A COVERED BRIDGE


TOTAL: 65 miles, drive time 1 hr. 42 mins



- Route 2 East to Newry 6 miles
- Left on Route 26 to Upton 28 miles
- Right on Andover Road/East B Hill Road to Andover – 14 miles
- Right on Route 5 to Rumford Point 11 miles
- Right on Route 2 to Bethel 12 miles

Grafton Notch State Park is an absolute must-do when visiting the Bethel area. Pack a picnic for Screw Auger Falls, a stunning waterfall. Perhaps leave time for a short hike up to

Table Rock, or the Eyebrow, both viewpoints on the Appalachian Trail. There's a great chance you may see some wildlife. A right turn on the Andover Road/ East B Hill Road delivers you to the bucolic village of Andover. Pastures dot the landscape as you travel back south along Route 5. Keep your eye out for the Lovejoy covered bridge over the Ellis River for a perfect photo op. Travel back toward Bethel along the Androscoggin River.



PADDLING - CANOES, KAYAKS, AND SUPS

With boat launches accessible every few miles, the Androscoggin River allows you to choose whether to be out for a couple hours or all day long. Canoe and kayak rentals are readily available from Bethel Outdoor Adventure, which also

Sport Thoma will deliver your preferred paddle-powered boat to your water body of choice, whether it's to your waterfront vacation rental or to one of the designated boat landings on the various rivers or lakes throughout the area.

Head north to Errol, NH for more paddling options and whitewater rafting with Northern Waters Outfitters. Three classic New England rivers adjacent to the Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge within an hour's drive of Bethel are home to whitewater ranging from mild to wild. Closest to Bethel is the Androscoggin River—as it emerges from Lake Umbagog, it offers an excellent introduction

to rafting for first-timers or families. The Magalloway River is a great choice for groups looking for a little more excitement, with myriad twists and turns and near Class III/IV rapids. The Rapid River is a steep, remote, class IV river that connects lower Richardson Lake to Lake Umbagog. Nestled deep in the Maine wilderness, it sees little traffic, making for a unique

- Constantly expanding, Bethel Community Forest has more than 6 miles of trails - beginner to expert.

ROAD BIKING

BETHEL RECREATIONAL PATHWAY



Plenty of on-mountain lodging and dining options and truly legendary snowmaking and grooming add up to a resort that will keep you coming back for more. sundayriver.com

Mt. Abram offers 51 trails for all ability levels across 550 acres and a boundary-to-boundary ski policy. Known for being family-friendly, environmentally conscious, and community-minded, Mt. XC SKIING, SNOWSHOEING, AND FATBIKING

Inland Woods and Trails (woodsandtrail.org) at The Bethel Resort & Suites offers 25K of groomed Nordic ski trails and 10K of additional fatbiking and snowshoeing trails right on the edge of Bethel village. Carter's XC Ski Center (cartersxcski.com) has 55K with tremendous views of Sunday River, the Mahoosuc Mountain Range, and the Presidentials, plus a full-service shop. Both also offer snowshoeing, gear rentals, and lessons.

Prefer to strike out on your own? Mahoosuc Land Trust (mahoosuc.org) has snowshoes to borrow at its Valentine Farm Conservation Center, or rent from True North Adventureware (truenorthadventureware.com) and head out on any hiking trail you choose.

Snowmobiling is widely available with a network of trails around the area connecting to the services and amenities in Bethel. Bring your own machines, or rent from **Northeast Snowmobile & ATV** (northeastsnowmobile.com) in nearby Gorham, NH.





MAINE MINERAL & GEM MUSEUM

The Maine Mineral and Gem Museum, occupying 15,000 square feet on Main Street in Bethel, showcases the area's geological history, truly extraordinary displays of minerals, rocks, and gemstones, and is committed to providing educational opportunities for everyone from young kids to international experts. Maine is widely known for its quality and quantity of gems such as tourmaline in a rainbow of colors, amethyst, beryl, many varieties of quartz, mica and so much more, from the practical to the beautiful.

In addition to the finest collection of Maine minerals and gems, MMGM displays one of the world's foremost collections of extraterrestrial rocks—meteorites from Mars, the Moon and the Asteroid Belt that teach us about the origins of our Solar System, including the five largest pieces of the Moon on Earth!

MUSEUMS OF THE BETHEL HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Two of the oldest buildings on the Bethel Town Common, the 1821 O'Neil Robinson House and the 1813 Dr. Moses Mason House, comprise the Museums of the Bethel Historical Society. It features over a dozen ever-evolving exhibit galleries and period rooms. MBHS brings history to life through children's programs, lectures, and community events. MBHS also maintains an extensive library and archival collection of books, manuscripts, and photographs, plus thousands of historic objects that tell the story of the town of Bethel and surrounding region. bethelhistorical.org




